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Notes:

1. Must not hold any TC pilot licence. Must turn 16 by 1 Sep 11, be physically fit, be certified medically fit (Cat 3) by a [Canadian Civil Aviation Medical Examiner](#)
2. Must be 17 by 1 Sep 11, be physically fit, be certified medically fit (Cat 3) by a Canadian Civil Aviation Medical Examiner
3. Staff Applications do not require a summer training application; a separate staff request form is required. Staff Cadets must be 16 years of age by January 1 2011 to be eligible.
4. Music Courses are for band members only and require a DND757 form approved and completed by the Band Officer.
5. National courses are only for the senior cadets and have a separate application procedure that must be approved by the CO.
 - a. A cadet may only apply for one course amongst IACE, GPS or PPS.
 - b. A cadet may only apply for one course amongst AATC-AO, AATC-AM, AASC, OT.
6. This course is usually reserved for cadets who applied for Power and Glider and didn't get selected. Before selecting this course please talk with CI Biffin.
7. ***Any cadet that turns 19 years of age before the end of summer training is not eligible to submit an application.***
8. ***Please note that any cadet with a severe allergy to Bee Stings will NOT be accepted for Summer Training at the Blackdown summer training centre. .***
